NBNA SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM – Written Essay Guidelines

Each applicant is to submit with the application a two-page typed, 12 pitch font size, 1” margins, and double-spaced essay. Essay to include a description of extracurricular activities and community involvement. These may include (but not be limited to) local chapter activities, community based projects, school level projects, organizational efforts, state level student nurse activities, activities impacting on the health and social condition of African Americans and other culturally diverse groups. Also include a presentation of your ideas of what you can do as an individual nurse to improve the health status and/or social condition of African Americans and a statement about your future goals in nursing.
